**DO NOT BRING**: money, candy, gum, food of any kind, flashlights, knives, hatchets, matches, hair spray, and other spray items, radios, walkmans, electronic games, cell phones, hair dryers, makeup, perfume, curling irons, or dangling earrings. We recommend <u>not</u> bringing a watch or jewelry of any kind. If brought, we will not be held responsible for lost or damaged items.
